Rent a cabin

There are two different cabin areas. Skogsbyn features newly built cabins that sleep up to eight people (6+2), while Nalobyn offers classic, cosy cabins that sleep up to six people (4+2). All cabins include a kitchen and a bathroom.



Caravan site

We offer plenty of spaces for caravans and motorhomes. You'll have access to electricity and our service building, which includes a fully equipped kitchen, freezer, showers, WC, sauna, TV, and WiFi.

Nalovardo is surrounded by several rivers and lakes, home to species such as grayling, trout, whitefish, perch, pike, and in some areas, salmon.

Bräskaforsen

Within walking distance from the Nalovardo cabin village, you'll find Bräskaforsen in the Vindelälven River. This area is known for its excellent grayling fishing and offers exciting fishing opportunities.

Vindelälven

The majestic Vindelälven is one of Sweden's few unregulated large rivers and is considered one of the best fishing waters in the country. Stretching 450 km from the Norwegian mountains to the coast, the river is home to salmon, trout, whitefish, burbot, grayling, perch, and pike.

A short drive upstream will bring you to Ammarnäs, famous for its sought-after

Laisälven

Laisälven river runs from its origin at Nasafjället, close to the Norwegian border, and flows through Nalovardo. This fishing gem is a great spot for fly and spin fishing, particularly for trout and grayling.
